

BLACK PIONEERS IN HEALTH FROM THE BAY AREA

DR. JAMES HUTCHINSON




ONE OF THE FIRST AFRICAN-AMERICAN DOCTORS IN CALIFORNIA, AND THE FIRST IN THE BAY AREA. DR. JAMES PRACTICED FAMILY MEDICINE IN SAN MATEO CALIFORNIA ALONG WITH RECEIVING HIS DEGREE FROM MEHARRY MEDICAL COLLEGE OF MEDICINE A HISTORICAL BLACK COLLEGE IN 1952. HE IS ONE OF THE FOUNDING DOCTORS OF PLANNED PARENTHOOD AND PROJECT GO.



DR. EARL RANDOLPH MEYERS

DR. MEYERS WAS A PHYSICIAN AND SURGEON WHO PRACTICED MEDICINE UNTIL THE AGE OF 85 AND WAS KNOWN AMONG HIS COLLEAGUES AS "THE FATHER OF BLACK MEDICINE IN FRESNO." DR. MEYERS, WHO DIED IN 2014, AT THE AGE OF 95, OPENED HIS FIRST MEDICAL CLINIC IN 1947 IN DOWNTOWN FRESNO. AFTER 10 YEARS AS THE ONLY AFRICAN-AMERICAN PHYSICIAN IN THE FRESNO AREA, DR. MEYERS BEGAN TO ENCOURAGE OTHER AFRICAN-AMERICAN DOCTORS TO BRING THEIR SERVICES TO FRESNO. HE BUILT THE FRESNO-KLETTE MEDICAL ARTS CENTER, THE FIRST MEDICAL FACILITY OWNED BY LOCAL AFRICAN AMERICANS, IN WEST FRESNO IN 1957.

JOSEPH L. WHITE



DR. JOSEPH L. WHITE, OFTEN REFERRED TO AS "THE FATHER OF BLACK PSYCHOLOGY," WROTE THE REVOLUTIONARY ARTICLE CALLED, "TOWARD A BLACK PSYCHOLOGY," WHICH WAS FEATURED IN EBONY MAGAZINE. HE IS CREDITED FOR HIS WORK FOR BEING THE FIRST STRENGTHS-BASED ANALYSIS AND EVALUATION OF BLACK BEHAVIOR AND CULTURE. DR. WHITE ADVOCATED FOR THE CREATION OF BLACK PSYCHOLOGY, ARGUING THAT THE APPLICATION OF WHITE PSYCHOLOGY ON AFRICAN AMERICAN PEOPLE DEVELOPED AN UNFAIR ILLUSION OF BLACK INFERIORITY. DR. WHITE HELPED FOUND THE ASSOCIATION OF BLACK PSYCHOLOGISTS AND SAN FRANCISCO STATE UNIVERSITY'S BLACK STUDIES PROGRAM IN 1968.

DR. ARTHUR COLEMAN

DR. ARTHUR COLEMAN, THE FIRST BLACK PHYSICIAN WHO
BUILT A PRACTICE IN S.F. AND STARTED THE TRANSBAY SAVINGS
BANK TO PROVIDE MORTGAGE DR. COLEMAN SERVED ON THE SAN
FRANCISCO PORT COMMISSION THROUGH THE 1980S. DURING
THAT DECADE, HE GREW FRUSTRATED THAT RESIDENTS OF
BAYVIEW-HUNTERS POINT WERE EXPERIENCING HIGH INCIDENCES
OF ASTHMA, BREAST CANCER AND PROSTATE CANCER AND WERE
NOT GETTING REGULAR CHECKUPS. IN RESPONSE, HE HELPED
CREATE THE BAYVIEW-HUNTERS POINT HEALTH AND
ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCE CENTER.



NADINE BURKE HARRIS



NADINE BURKE HARRIS MADE HISTORY WHEN SHE WAS APPOINTED AS CALIFORNIA'S FIRST SURGEON GENERAL IN JANUARY 2019 BY GOVERNOR GAVIN NEWSOM. HOWEVER, THE PEDIATRICIAN'S CAREER STARTED IN SAN FRANCISCO A DECADE AND A HALF PRIOR TO HER TAKING ON THIS PREEMINENT ROLE. BURKE HARRIS JOINED THE CALIFORNIA PACIFIC MEDICAL CENTER (CPMC) STAFF IN 2005 AND WAS TASKED WITH DEVELOPING PROGRAMS TO END HEALTH DISPARITIES IN SAN FRANCISCO – WITH SUPPORT FROM CPMC, TWO YEARS LATER BURKE HARRIS BECAME THE MEDICAL DIRECTOR AND FOUNDING PHYSICIAN OF THE BAYVIEW CHILD HEALTH CENTER. FROM 2010 TO 2012, SHE CO-FOUNDED THE ADVERSE CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCES PROJECT IN THE BAYVIEW-HUNTERS POINT NEIGHBORHOOD IN SAN FRANCISCO, WITH COLLEAGUES FUTURE VICE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES KAMALA HARRIS.

HABEN GIRMA

HABEN GIRMA WAS BORN DEAF-BLIND IN OAKLAND IN 1988
TO AN ERITREAN MOTHER AND ETHIOPIAN FATHER. SHE HAS
AN OLDER BROTHER, MUSSIE, WHO WAS ALSO DEAF-BLIND,
AND THEY WERE BOTH EDUCATED IN OAKLAND'S PUBLIC
SCHOOL SYSTEM. MUSSIE WENT ON TO BECOME A
TECHNOLOGY ADVISOR AND DISABILITY ADVOATE, WHILE
HABEN WENT ON TO GRADUATE MAGNA CUM LAUDE FROM
LEWIS & CLARK COLLEGE IN PORTLAND.

THEN SHE MADE HISTORY BY BECOMING THE FIRST DEAF-BLIND PERSON TO GRADUATE FROM HARVARD LAW SCHOOL IN 2013. AFTER GRADUATING, SHE MOVED BACK TO THE BAY AREA TO WORK FOR DISABILITY RIGHTS ADVOCATES IN BERKELEY AS A SKADDEN FELLOW AND NOW SHE WORKS FULL-TIME AS A NON-LITIGATION DISABILITY RIGHTS ADVOCATE.
